

MANAGING COMMODITY INFORMATION FOR IMPORT SECURITY FILING

The Safe Port Act of 2006 became law in the United States at the end of 2006. The act calls for the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to require specific manifest and cargo data from importers and the carrier 24 hours prior to the vessel departure at the origin port. The requirement has been named within the US Customs and Border Protection (CBP) as the Importer Security Filing (ISF) or 10+2.

Integrate with your ERP, suppliers and logistics services.

One of the 10 data elements required by ISF is the commodity HS number. While many importers today strive to preclassify items before they arrive at destination, ISF will require knowledge of the commodity HS number 24 hours before loading at the origin port. Having a comprehensive classification compliance program in place before the paradigm shift will be crucial to minimize risk of supply chain delays. How well you manage the process to classify imports before they are ready to depart, and share that information securely with your trade partners, will have a large impact on your import compliance with respect to the Importer Security Filing.

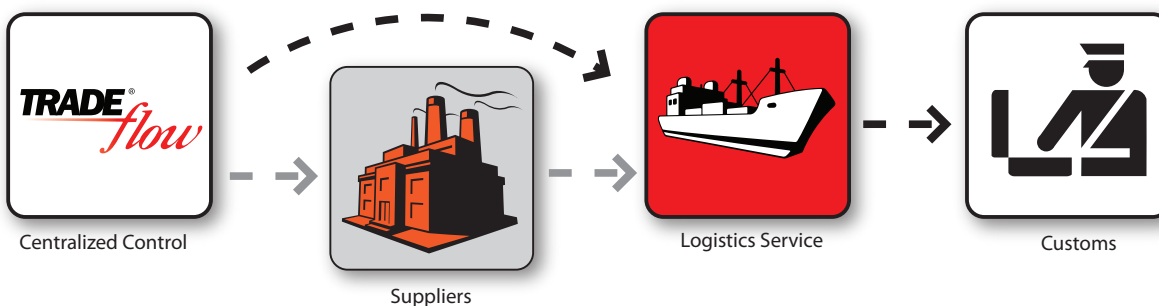
