

RING ROAD PROJECT

Current Situation:

- Ha Noi Hai Phong National Road No#5 (Blue line): Low toll fee but overloaded capacity, truck congestion sometimes, long driving hours, no plan for expansion until 2030.
- Ha Noi Hai Phong Express Highway (Red line): High toll fee, modern, short driving hours and no congestion.

Proposed Plan:

Ring Road No.4 target to complete by 2026 and to be open to traffic in early 2027.



Impact:

Enhances connectivity between Hanoi and northern provinces, driving regional socio-economic growth.

Supports population decentralization to ease flooding, traffic congestion, and pollution in urban areas.



Overall capacity supply & demand growth [indexed], simplified view




TONNAGE PERFORMANCE

- The strongest market is Americas, followed by Europe and North Asia.







CONTAINER THROUGHPUT IN VIETNAM


